Rollout Cart Schedule

Carts cannot be placed on the curb before 5p the day prior to your scheduled pick up and they must be in no later than 7 p.m. the day of your scheduled pick up. Enforcement penalties may apply if not followed.

Dry Trash

What is Dry Trash? Dry trash or "Yard Waste" generally includes: grass clippings, leaves, twigs, branches and other woody material up to 3 inches in diameter and no longer than 4 feet in length. Bagged dirt, soil, and items such as rocks are NOT considered yard waste and will not be picked up by WM.

Where do I place my dry trash materials? All bags and bundles of dry trash must be placed beside your household trash container on pickup day. Items such as sticks and branches that cannot be bagged must be tied into bundles. Each bundle or bag cannot weigh more than 45 pounds each.

Important Cart Placement Information


Place your cart at least 3 feet away from all objects including your second cart, mailbox, car, or tree to enable the automatic arm to lift and empty the carts. The lid opening should face the street with the wheels of the cart facing your house. Please don't park your car in front of the cart as the truck will not be able to service your cart.

Curbside Bulk Pickup

Your bulk collection day is the same day as your recycling pickup, biweekly. (Recycling & bulk items will not be picked up in the same truck.) Items placed on the curb earlier than 24 hours prior to your scheduled day or remaining on the curb after your scheduled day may be subject to a violation of Garden City Code.

Guidelines

- Place item at the curb by 6 a.m.
- No earlier than 24 hours before
- Do not block sidewalk or road
- Put 3 ft of clearance from recycle cart
- Items cannot exceed 100 pounds
- Items shall be no larger than 6 ft long, 5 ft tall, & 5 ft wide
- Appliances are to be certified free of CFC's



Acceptable Items

- Stoves
- Air Conditioners
- Dishwashers
- Refrigerators
- Washing Machines & Dryers
- Couches & Chairs

Unacceptable Items

- TV's & Electronics
- Mattresses
- Construction Materials
- Hazardous Waste
- Automotive Parts & Tires
