



General Terms and Conditions

Buyer's submissions will be evaluated by the City staff based upon the required submittals listed above. Based on evaluation of the required submittal materials, City staff will select a top ranked buyer for consideration. Upon approval by the City Fire Chief, the selected buyer and the City will negotiate a purchase and sale agreement for the fire truck. No financial assistance will be provided by the City. The buyer shall be solely responsible for securing all necessary funding for the purchase of the property.

The fire truck shall be transferred from the City without representation, covenant, or warranty of any kind and the buyer shall accept the Property in an "as is" and "where is" condition, with all faults. The buyer shall make its own conclusions concerning the conditions of the property. Any information provided in the proposal documentation or otherwise by City staff is provided for the convenience of the buyer only and is not intended to be exhaustive. The accuracy or completeness of any information provided is not warranted by or a representation of the City.

The City reserves the right to modify or cancel the selection process or negotiations at any time; waive minor irregularities; reject any and all proposals and seek new submissions when it is in the best interest of the City to do so; and seek clarification or additional information or evidence from individual buyers.
