Stormwater refers to rainfall/snow melt that has fallen to the ground and flows over the land and/or infiltrates the ground.

Stormwater Management Program

The City of Garden City has developed a Stormwater Management Plan (SWMP) as required by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division (EPD). This Plan provides a comprehensive framework for inspecting and maintaining City stormwater infrastructure and how the City will address water quality issues, enforce stormwater requirements, and educate the public about important stormwater best management practices (BMPs).
